Supervisor Anderson told the Board Town and Country Bridge and Rail finished the guardrail work up on Fox Hill Road, they were paid \$47,500.00 under prepaids for this month, but after looking at the bill there was an additional fee of \$2,783.00 that is due. He will need to move this amount from Contingency to cover the additional fee with Boards approval.

Informational Items

Boiler Inspection

The boiler has been inspected, it passed; but we have to open the expansion valve and report it each month.

Time Clocks, Cloud Subscription

Supervisor Anderson wanted to know if the Board is willing to enter into a cloud subscription for \$25.00 per month to have the information for time clocks.

Surveillance Cameras

The cameras have been installed and are working. They have been installed in and outside the Town Hall. Outside the Highway Garage/Justice Court building and at the Recycle and Reuse Center. You will notice the signage up.

Contact M. from Benetech – Health Insurance

Supervisor Anderson will be contacting Marissa our representative from Benetech concerning insurance coverage for the 2026 year.

Confidential Secretary/Receptionist

Supervisor Anderson is considering looking for a confidential secretary and or receptionist, the Town Hall is getting busier and an extra hand would help.

Risk Assessment Report

Supervisor Anderson told the Board he has not had the results of the risk assessment sent to him as of yet from NYMIR.

Cemetery Fence Update

The Town has received the insurance money for the damage that was done at the Edinburg Cemetery, Siena Fence was contacted, they are booked through the middle of August. Letter Memorial will be working on the stones that have been damaged.

Complaints, Batchellerville Bridge

Supervisor Anderson reported there have been a number of complaint calls about the Batchellerville Bridge lights. He has contacted C. Cook, Commissioner of Public Works from Saratoga County and has

been told that there was \$30,000.00 they had to put into the budget to cover the cost of the lights. Now Supervisor Anderson has been told he will need to speak to someone in maintenance to take care of this. Supervisor Anderson told the Board the rail for the walkway under the bridge was hit by a motorcycle that was down there doing donuts and broken the railing. This is a large issue, if someone leans on it, they will fall and get hurt. The County is supposed to take care of this also.

Retirement Reports

The NYS Retirement is almost complete. Supervisor Anderson and the bookkeeper have been working on this; they had to get everything loaded individually for the workers beginning in July of 2024 to date. The Town is going to have to enter into an enhancement system once this is done for retirement.

Annual Financial Report for 2024

The annual financial report has not been filed yet. There were some glitches in the software that has set the bookkeeper back we were originally told to start entering from 2019 and were later told to start with 2024; this caused numbers from 2019 to be integrated in with the 2024 numbers. She is working on getting fixed and to get it finished.

Supervisor's Monthly Report

This problem has also set us back as far as giving monthly Supervisor's reports to the Board. We are almost there.

Purchasing AED's

Supervisor Anderson said he had initially asked to purchase AEDs for the Town Hall and the Recycle Center; but once he saw the prices he decided to wait. He is now again asking for the Boards permission to purchase two AED's that are the same as the Fire Company uses. We do have certified people, both myself and Assessor Beckering can use them here and SWC Olmstead, Recycle Center and Highway Superintendent Seelow, Highway can use them too. Highway Superintendent Seelow actually carries one in his truck. The cost would be \$1400.00 each. The Board would like him to get other prices. Supervisor Anderson will check to see what other prices he can find. Once we get them, we will have to register with REMO and we will have to file reports.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

New Truck

Highway Superintendent Seelow told the Board the new tandem truck has been ordered.

Paving

The paving has been completed on Bradt Hill, Wheeler and Airport Road. The Highway Department will be paving Sand Lake and King Roads on August 11th and 12th.

SOLID WASTE COORDINATOR

1 lb. Propane Tanks

SWC Olmstead asked what the Board would like to do about the 1lb. propane tanks they are still a problem and it is hard to get rid of them. G. Whitney from Providence said he may take them, but if he doesn't what do you want to do. J. Olmstead will see what other centers are doing with them.

Metal Removal and Purchase

Metro Metal was contacted concerning the towns metal and the possibility of the town getting paid for it. They want to charge us for mileage, taking off tires on lawnmowers etc. They did not think our metal was worth it for them to pick up. This will be looked at further.

Solar

Josh from CDRPC, Bob Schmidt and John Olmstead have been in contact with National Solar concerning the bid for the placement of solar panels on the Salt Shed and for the Recycle Center. Josh is finishing up the information on the mini bid through the State of New York. SWC Olmstead said he does not think it needs to go out to bid.

NEW/OLD BUSINESS

Investments

Town Board Member Penino asked what was Supervisor Anderson doing with investments she stated the Board wanted to move ahead with this and wanted to know what is being done. Supervisor Anderson told her he had just moved \$700,000.00 into the Highway portion of the 2025 budget to cover this portion of the budget. She was concerned we have already waited six months; Supervisor Anderson told her there is \$500,000.00 he could invest from the General Fund which has \$1,000,000.00, but he is looking at Key Bank too, they have some good offers that NBT does not. He said he can call the Board back and see what they want to do once he gets all of the information.

Minor Contracts, Protection for Individuals, Air B and B's

The Town Board further discussed the minor contracts, protecting an individual's credit air b and b's at this point in time the county is still working on the rules from the State of New York concerning rental properties, once they get it figured out, we will know what we have to do.

2026 Budget

Supervisor Anderson told the Board he will be working on the budget for next month.

Stairs, Copeland Covered Bridge

Supervisor Anderson notified the Historical Society the stairs on the backside of the Copeland Covered Bridge are in disrepair. The first step is missing. He went down and put caution tape there so no one would try to use them.
